### **Web Site Contest**

**Aim of Website Contest** – The aims of the contest are twofold:

1. To encourage the clubs to develop a website as a communication and public relations tool.
2. To encourage the clubs to enter their website in the annual Lions Clubs International Contest.

**District By-Laws** – the following wording is extracted from the District By-Laws

*Clause 14.5 - Judging Criteria*

*(l) The winner of the District Trophy for Club Website shall be judged on the quality of content and design by the District Governor, Cabinet Secretary, Webmaster and Public Relations Chairman. Clubs wishing to be enter the competition shall, no later that 1 May in the year in which they will be judged, submit to the Cabinet Secretary a sample hard copy consisting of 10 to 20 pages of their website and include the URL of the website. The winner shall receive (a) the perpetual trophy which is to be returned after 1 year and (b) a framed certificate to keep.*

#### **Contest Rules**

1. The contest is open to all Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs in District 201N5.
2. All clubs entering the competition must submit a sample hard copy consisting of 10 to 20 pages of their Web site and include the URL on the Website Contest Entry Form (see below).
3. Entries must reach the Cabinet Secretary by **May 1** of the year in which they'll be judged.
4. Web sites will be judged for quality of content and design.
